**I. Call to Order**

Nafziger called the meeting to order at 5:31PM.

**II. Motion to Amend Agenda**

**III. Approval of September 17, 2018 Park Board Minutes**

Nafziger called for a motion to approve the Park Board Minutes for September 17, 2018. On a motion by Wellington, seconded by Yoder, ayes carried.

**V. Approval of Park Gifts, September, 2018**

Nafziger called for a motion to approve the parks gifts for September 2018 as presented. On a motion by Wellington, seconded by Shell, ayes carried.

**VIII. Approval of Superintendent and Director Reports**

Nafziger called for a motion to approve the Superintendent and Director Reports for August 2018 as well as September 2018 as presented. On a motion by Wellington, seconded by Yoder, ayes carried.

**IX. New Business**

**1.) Model Elementary School Lease Agreement**

Heyde presented the Board with a lease agreement from Model Elementary to use their gymnasium for park activities at no cost. Heyde requested the Board approve and ratify the lease agreement as presented. On a motion by Wellington, seconded by Shell, ayes carried.

**2.) Patronicity Agreement**

Heyde presented the Board with an Agreement from CreatINg Places, a crowdfunding platform used by Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority, to raise funds for the inclusive playground. Heyde explained through the IHCD's CreatINg Places initiative, if our fundraising goal of \$50,000 is reached, the IHCD will match the raised funds for a total of \$100,000. The crowdfunding campaign will run from October 22 through December 11. Heyde requested approval to execute and enter in to the agreement as presented and pending legal review. On a motion by Wellington, seconded by Shell, ayes carried.

**3.) 2019 Budget**

Heyde presented the Board with the 2019 budget. Heyde requested the Board ratify and approve the 2019 budget as presented. On a motion by Wellington, seconded by Yoder, ayes carried.

**4.) Water Tower Park, Parking Lot Update**

Heyde explained to the Board that the Parks Department is working with both the Engineering Department and the Street Department to get the parking lot constructed in-house. The excavating and grade work will have to be contracted out.

**5.) Master Plan Update**

Heyde updated the Board on the past and future Public Master Plan Meetings. Heyde informed the Board, Sharon Hernandez our City Communications Coordinator, has posted a public survey questionnaire in both English and Spanish on the City/Parks' website & Park/City's Facebook page. Heyde explained she had a Coordination meeting with Elkhart County Parks, Elkhart Parks and Nappanee Parks who are also in their 5 year Master Planning to discuss ideas and the possibility of meeting monthly/bi-monthly to continue to discuss ideas. Steve Troyer from the Troyer Group did a pop up event at First Fridays.

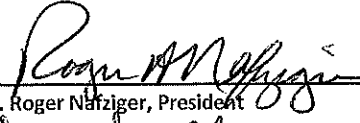

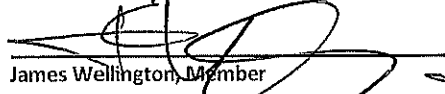

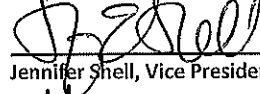
